Responsibility

Management is responsible for:

- The provision and maintenance of the workplace in a safe condition and resources to meet the health and safety objectives and commitment
- Involvement in the development, promotion and implementation of health and safety policies and procedures, including training to employees in the safe performance of their assigned tasks

Employees and contractors working for Osmoflo are to:

- Report all known or observed hazards to their immediate supervisor or manager
- Follow all health and safety policies and procedures

Consultation

Osmoflo also is committed to consultation and cooperation between management and employees. The organisation will consult with elected employee health and safety representatives and employees in any workplace change that will affect the health and safety of any of its employees.
